The contract included a 2nd year firm fixed price option to renew for one (1) additional year. BDF Industrial Fasteners, Aall American Fasteners and GKY Industries submitted their 2nd year firm price with an 1.01% overall cost increase. This requirement was originally publicly advertised and issued to twelve (12) prospective bidders. Four (4) bids were received and publicly opened on September 9, 2015. Bid was structured to award on "low bid per item" or "overall low bid" basis. DRPA determined most cost advantageous benefit to award on a "low bid per item basis", resulting in \$3,128.66 cost savings to the DRPA. Bid includes 463 fastener line items, which will be provided contractually for a one (1) year period on an "as needed basis".
